Suggested wording

We suggest you use the following wording when donating to Lucy Cavendish via your will.

"I give to the President and Fellows of Lucy Cavendish College in the University of Cambridge (registered as an exempt charity with Inland Revenue 1137875), [the residue]/ [% of the residue] of my estate [or] [the sum of £x] free of tax to be used for the general purposes of the College. The receipt of the Bursar of the College shall be sufficient to discharge to my Executors."

YOUR LEGACY. YOUR CHOICE.

You can choose exactly what your legacy will be.

An **unrestricted legacy** is particularly valuable to the College, because it enables us to respond flexibly to areas of the greatest need.

You may prefer to give funds to a particular area of the College that is meaningful to you – perhaps research, student support or scholarships, the Library or the gardens.

Whatever you decide, we will respect your choice.
